

Advance notice: Low-flying aircraft

Have you heard of the Tellus survey?
It may be relevant to you.



What?

An aircraft will fly at a low level of 60m over rural areas collecting geological information. The aircraft will rise to 240m over urban areas. You may see the plane pass at 240m on its way to survey areas. The white, twin propeller plane has a red tail, black stripe, and registration number C-GSGF. The sound of the plane is similar to that of a passing lorry, however it may startle sensitive animals, such as horses.



Where?

Across eastern Waterford, parts of southern Tipperary, Kilkenny and western Wexford. The plane will turn over neighbouring areas.



Why?

The work is part of the Tellus survey which is collecting geochemical and geophysical information on our rocks, soil and water. The data will be freely available to all. The information will be used by the Geological Survey to make new geological maps, supporting environmental management, agriculture and natural resources assessment.

When?

Due to commence in April, the survey aircraft will fly during spring 2016. Please note, the flight schedule is weather-dependent and is subject to change. Please contact us for up-to-date flight plans.

Tá fuaim an eitleán cosúil le fuaim leoráí a bheadh ag dul thar bráid, ach d'fhéadfadh sé cur isteach ar ainmhithe fogaire, capaill go háirithe.

Cén áit?

Ar fud Phort Láirge Thoir, codanna de Thiobraid Árann Theas, Cill Chainnigh agus Loch Garman Thiar. Casfaidh an t-eitleán os cionn ceantair atá gar dóibh sin.

Cén fáth?

Is cuid den tsuirbhéireacht Tellus í an obair. Sa tsuirbhéireacht sin táthar ag bailiú faisnéis gheoiceimiceach agus gheofisiceach ar na carraigeacha, ar an ithir agus ar an uisce. Beidh na sonrái ar fáil do chách gan bac ar bith. Bainfidh an tSuirbhéireacht Gheolaíochta leas as an bhfaisnéis chun léarscáileanna nua geolaíocha a dhéanamh, rud a thacóidh le bainistíocht comhshaoil, leis an talmhaíocht agus le measúnú ar acmhainní nádúrtha.

Cén uair?


